

You are scheduled for surgery on _____ with

The hospital will call you in the afternoon the day prior to your procedure with your arrival time.

You need to have a responsible driver over the age of 18 to drive you home after surgery. The hospital also requires this person stay with you throughout the entire surgery.

One week before surgery, you are **TO STOP** taking aspirin, ibuprofen, medications containing aspirin, blood thinners, vitamin E, fish oil, or any other over the counter supplements and/ or pain relievers that may thin the blood. Failure to discontinue may result in your surgery being rescheduled. Should you have questions regarding your medication, please contact your pharmacy. Tylenol is allowed.

You should not have anything to eat, drink or smoke after midnight the night before your surgery.

If you had/have any medical/cardiac history, you will need to get a letter of clearance from your primary physician or cardiologist before we can perform your surgery.
